HOW OUR APPOINTMENTS ARE RELEASED:

GP (**General Practitioner**) - Released daily at 8:00am for same-day booking. A limited number of appointments are also released at 9am for exactly two weeks in advance for pre-booking.

ANP (Advanced Nurse Practitioner) - Follows the same system as GP appointments—released at 8am for same-day booking, with a small number available to pre-book two weeks ahead.

All other clinicians (including practice nurse, pharmacist and physiotherapist) — Appointments can be booked up to 6 weeks in advance.

WE ARE A 'BY APPOINTMENT ONLY' SERVICE

Appointments are available for various clinics including but not only limited to:

- ⇒ Child Health / Postnatal Checks
- ⇒ Social Prescribing
- ⇒ Minor Operations (skin tag/lesion removal)

HOME VISITS

Home visits should only be requested by patients who are unable to come to the surgery because of serious illness and infirmity. Please phone before 10:30am where possible if you are requesting a home visit.

NHS HEALTH CHECK

If you are a new patient and are age 40+ with no health conditions, take advantage of booking in for a health check. This will involve a blood test and checks such as blood pressure to check the status of your health and help to detect any underlying issues early.

ANNUAL HEALTH REVIEW

If you have a health condition such as diabetes, hypertension or asthma, you will automatically be invited in for an annual health check on or around your birthday.

CHAPERONES

If you would like a chaperone during your appointment, please let us know at the time of booking or inform your clinician.

Please allow 48 hours for your prescription to be processed by us and sent to the pharmacy. You may then need to allow for additional time for the pharmacy to have your prescription ready for collection. To nominate a pharmacy to collect your prescription at, please contact the practice.

There is a pharmacy available onsite, Well Pharmacy, which is open Monday to Friday, 9am—6pm. Please note, Well Pharmacy is an independent business and is not affiliated with the practice.

APPOINTMENT TEXT REMINDERS

We send appointment reminders via text approx. 48 hours before your appointment. Please ensure that if you no longer require your appointment that you respond to the text to cancel or call the practice. If your contact details change, please inform us.

NON-NHS SERVICES

GPs can perform medical examinations/reports for employers, solicitors, insurance companies and DVLA. Completion of this work is to the discretion of the GP. All non-NHS contracted work such as the above is subject to a fee and payment is required upfront.
